Dining Out in Panama City Beach

The restaurants that we have listed here are but a few of the choices that await you in Panama City Beach. Some of these listed we visit frequently, while others we haven't been to in a while. A few of these places are closed in the winter. The nearby spots are listed first.

Bikini Bob's Restaurant (on site) (seasonal)

Dine in or take out, this restaurant is not only convenient but also affordable. They serve good food with fast, friendly service. They are located at The Summit on the east end of the property by the outdoor hot tubs.

Spinnaker's Paradise Grill and **Spinnaker's Cantina** (next door)

You can order from either menu. Outside and inside dining. Summit guests: Look for 15% discount coupons in the rental office.

Hammerhead Fred's (directly across the street)

Good food and good services and good prices. Convenient location.

Mellow Mushroom (across the street next to Hammerhead Fred's)

Excellent pizza and Italian offerings are made from scratch which takes a little longer to prepare. The extra wait is worth it but may present a challenge for the little ones.

Guadalajara Mexican Grill (around the corner on Joan Avenue in the St. Thomas Square)

Saltwater Grill

One of our favorites, this restaurant features a large aquarium. The food and service are excellent. It is a little pricey but offers early bird specials. Located on Middle Beach Road a short distance on the right.

Bonefish Grill

The menu is limited but is a tasty fine dining choice. Located on Middle Beach Road at the Grand Panama entrance. (11535 Hutchison Blvd.)

Captain Anderson's

This legendary and award winning restaurant was founded in 1967. Known for its fresh seafood. The lines are long in peak season. Pricey. On the St. Andrews Marina on Thomas Drive. (5551 North Lagoon Drive)

Schooners

Nice beachfront restaurant. 5121 Gulf Drive.

Pineapple Willy's

Dine inside or outside on the pier. They serve a wide variety of tastes. Located at the west end of Thomas Drive.

Boatyard

Located on the marina just passed Capt. Anderson's. Enjoyable place to dine.

Angelo's Steak Pit

This one is a favorite of many. It is a little pricey but has great steaks. It has been around a long time. Located at 9527 Front Beach Road.

Firefly

This is an elegant, fine-dining place located on Front Beach Road in the Shoppes at Edgewater. If you ever ate at Canopies, this is where they moved. It is larger and has a different name. Very nice. Pricey, but check the early bird special.

Pier Park

There are 17 restaurants at Pier Park and more are located nearby. Check their website for a directory. There's Jimmy Buffet's Margaritaville, Hofbrau Beer Garden, Guy Harvey's Island Grill, Back Porch Seafood, Five Guys Burgers and Fries, Longhorn Steakhouse, Olive Garden, and Panera Bread, to name just a few.
